Students completing their high school sophomore year (ages 15-16) are eligible, although in some cases students completing either the freshman year may be selected.

The conference focuses on developing leadership skills, communication abilities and team-building tools and is scheduled from Friday, June 21 through Sunday, June 23. This unique opportunity brings young people from VT, NH, and Quebec together to share, evolve and learn to be more effective and self-confident leaders in their schools, teams, communities, and other facets of everyday life.

Acceptance into the program is competitive; it fills first-come-first-served. Your chances of getting in are much greater if you apply early. If you are selected by our Club, you will have to fill out a registration and release forms before you can attend.
